THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN FLAGSTAFF HAS ISSUED A

- * FLASH FLOOD WARNING FOR...
CENTRAL COCONINO COUNTY IN NORTH CENTRAL ARIZONA...
- * UNTIL 345 PM MST
- * AT 202 PM MST...TRAINED WEATHER SPOTTERS REPORTED FLASH FLOODING
FROM A THUNDERSTORM OVER THE SCHULTZ FIRE SITE IN CENTRAL COCONINO
COUNTY...OR 10 MILES NORTHEAST OF FLAGSTAFF...MOVING NORTH AT 10
MPH.
- * AUTOMATED RAIN GAGES ON THE FIRE ARE REPORTING ONE AND THREE
QUARTERS HALF INCHES OF RAIN ALREADY WITH THIS STORM. AS MUCH AS
AN INCH OF ADDITIONAL RAINFALL WILL FALL OVER THE BURN AREA BY 300
PM MST.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

THE HEAVY RAIN WILL LIKELY TRIGGER LIFE-THREATENING DEBRIS FLOWS AND
FLASH FLOODS WITHIN VULNERABLE DRAINAGES IN AND DOWNSTREAM OF THE
SCHULTZ FIRE BURN AREA. NORMALLY DRY WASHES IN THE WARNING AREA WILL
BECOME QUICKLY INUNDATED BY FLOODWATER AND A SLURRY OF SAND...SILT
AND ROCKS. BUILDINGS...ROADWAYS...AND CULVERTS NEAR THESE DRAINAGES
MAY INCUR SUBSTANTIAL DAMAGE.

THE SCHULTZ FIRE WILL CAUSE WATER LEVELS TO RISE MUCH MORE RAPIDLY
DURING FLASH FLOODS...AND MAY BE SIGNIFICANTLY LARGER THAN THOSE
PRODUCED WHEN THE WATERSHED WAS NOT BURNED.
