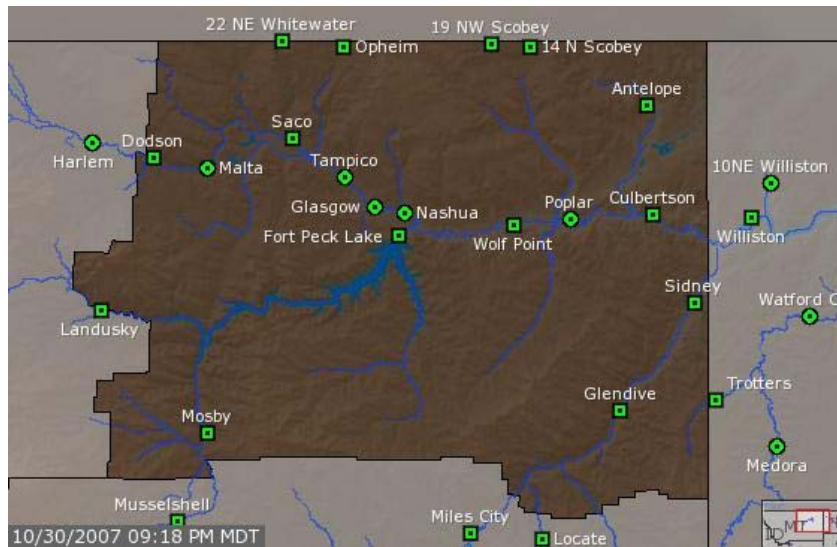


AHPS – Advanced Hydrologic Prediction System

The National Weather Service has developed the Advanced Hydrologic Prediction System to provide a one stop web site to view river stage data and forecast. To view Glasgow's AHPS page, the web site is located at www.weather.gov/glasgow then click on River & Lake AHPS on the blue menu bar on the left side of the page. On the Glasgow National Weather Service AHPS site, there is a map with 29 gage sites in and near Glasgow's forecast area.



AHPS allows anyone to easily monitor river gage heights and the elevation of some reservoirs like Fort Peck Lake. In addition to monitoring river heights, it is possible to view maps of recent precipitation, to check long term height probabilities at select locations on the Milk and Poplar Rivers, and access other hydrologic information from the AHPS page. Most gage locations have historical crest history and a few locations have low water record history. More information on AHPS can found at www.weather.gov/oh/ahps
