

Tepee Springs Flash Flood Potential



Type of rain needed for flash flooding:

- HIGH INTENSITY rainfall produced by thunderstorms.
- 0.40 inches of rain or more in 30 minutes.

Greatest risks:

- Lower sections of Allison Creek Road.
- Homes near the outlets of Rach Creek and Plant Creek.

Impacts:

- Fast, powerfully moving water.
- Debris flows (consisting of rock, mud, and trees) moving at very dangerous speeds.

BE ALERT!

Flash floods and debris flows can quickly inundate streams, channels, and low lying area; impacting roads, trail systems, and campgrounds.

**Be aware of any precipitation that develops!
DO NOT WAIT for a warning to evacuate.**

If rainfall is occurring in or upstream of your location, and you are in or near a burn scar area, **YOU ARE AT RISK!**
