On this day in...

2015: Strong thunderstorms hit northern Ventura and LA counties. Flash flooding and mud and debris flows occurred in the San Gabriel Mountains, Cuyama, and the Antelope Valley. Golf ball size hail in Leona Valley and quarter size hail in Palmdale were reported.

2004: This was the last day with no measurable rain in San Diego since 4/17, a streak of 182 consecutive days of no measurable rain, the longest on record.

1971: Mt. Laguna recorded its earliest measurable snowfall of the season on record.

1958: It was 106° in Santa Ana, the highest temperature on record for October.
