

Do You Need Certified Weather Records?

You need certified weather records for your court case. Where do you get them? The answer is the National Weather Service's National Climatic Data Center or NCDC. Located in Asheville, North Carolina, NCDC archives all U.S. weather data, such as forecasts and warning products as well as weather observations including Doppler weather radar and satellite imagery. Even National Weather Service (NWS) forecast offices use NCDC when they need archived weather data.
